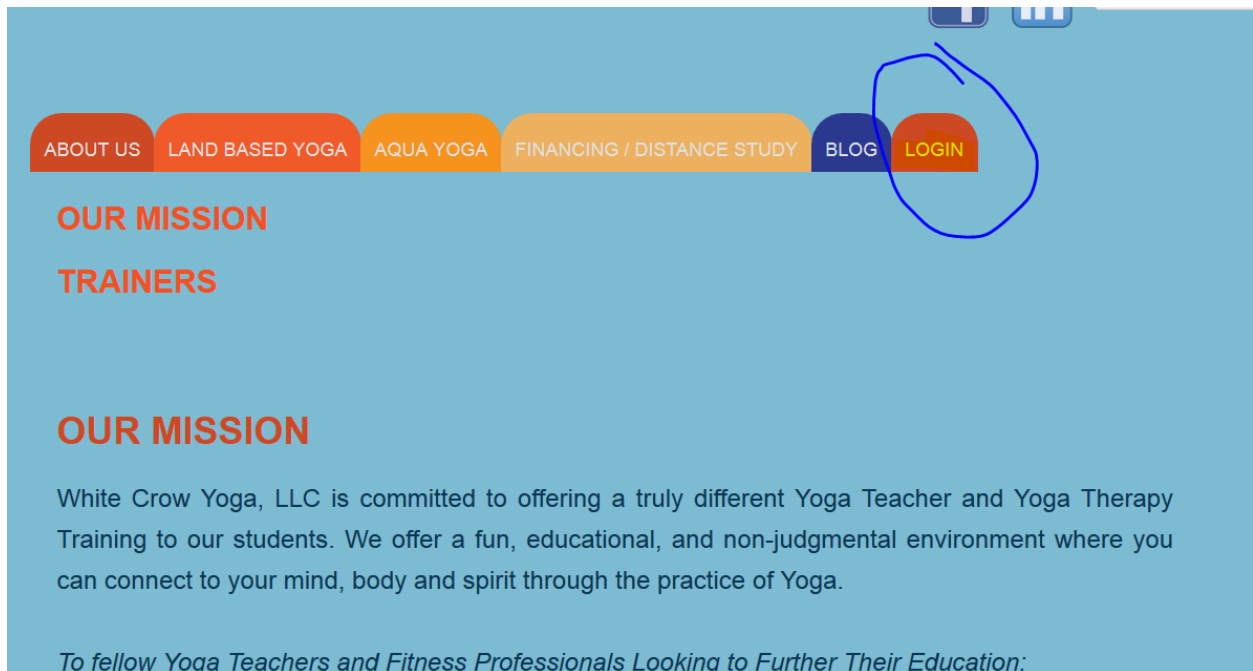


When you log in, you'll see the courses in which you are enrolled. Select the course you want to review.

In the example above, the student is enrolled in several classes, including a Live Workshop, CYT 200 Workshop – Home Study and CYT 200 Workshop – Online. If she wanted to look at the CYT 200 Workshop – Home Study, she would click that class, as shown in the highlighted example. **This is just an example – you will see whatever classes YOU are enrolled in.**

When you click on the class you want to look at (and you may be enrolled in only 1 or in multiple classes), you will see the components within them.

I'll show you an example of the RYT 200 Live Class below, but it works the same for all classes. Obviously, first you click the RYT 200 Live Class. First, click RYT 200 Live Class link (see below):

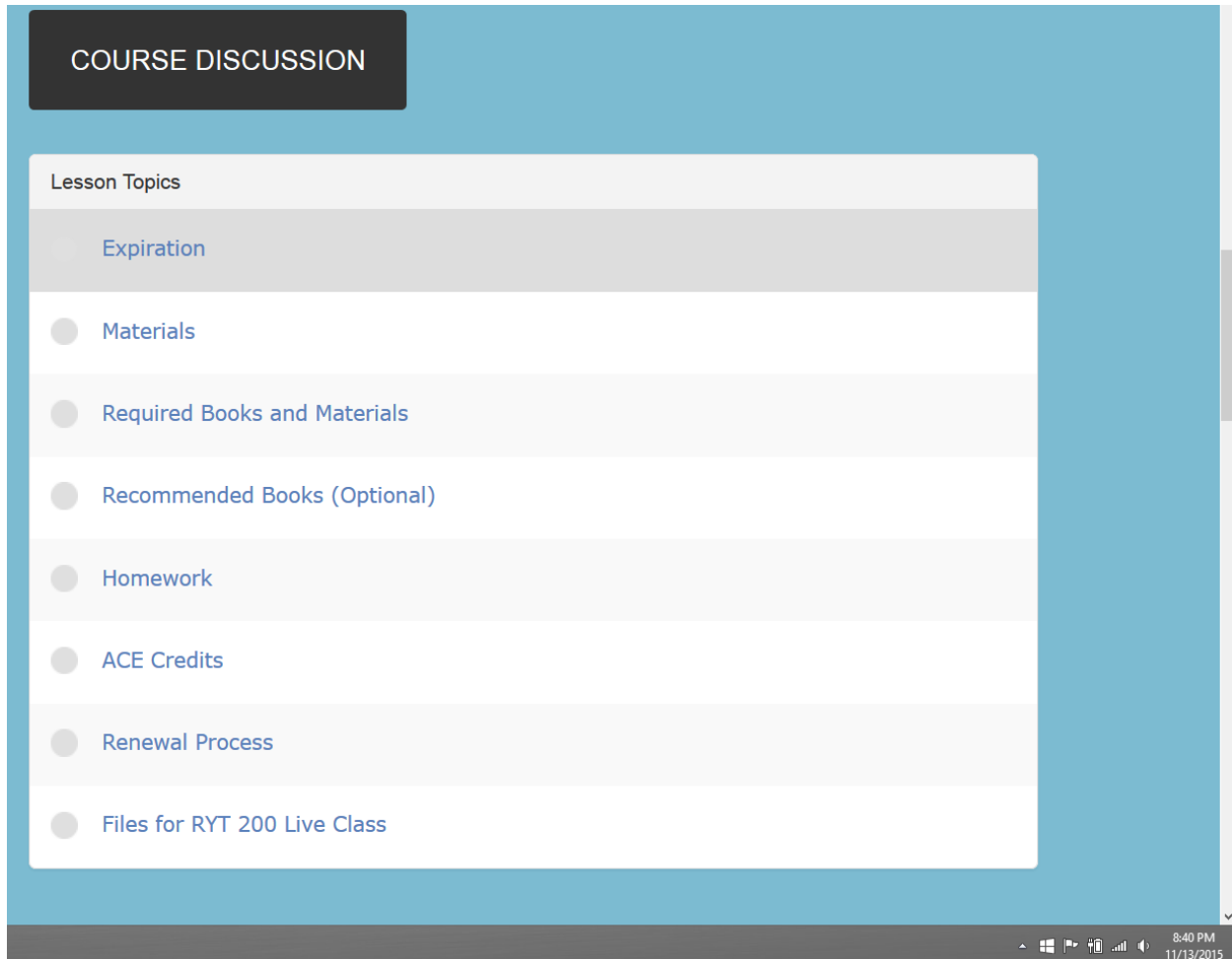

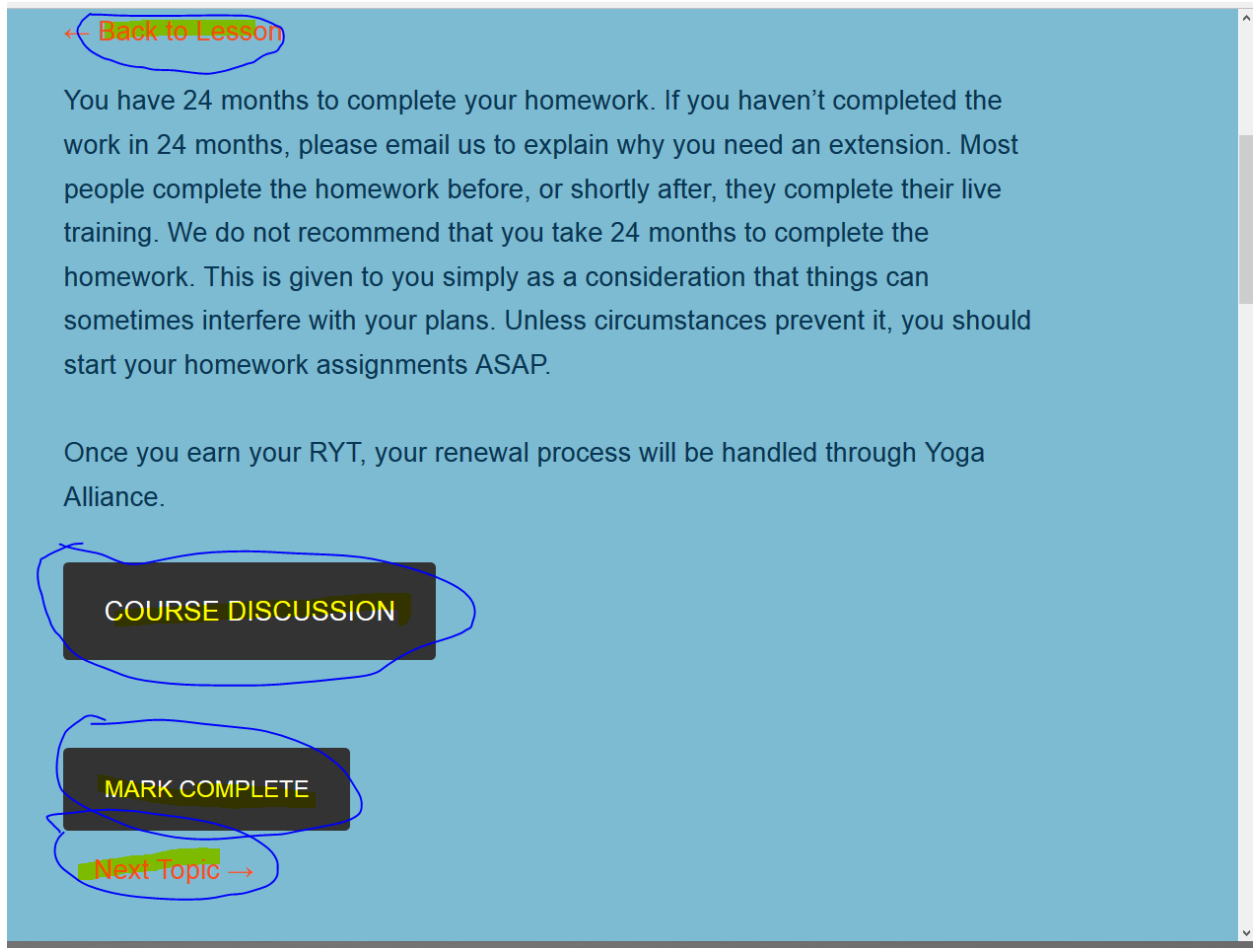

The default view is “Collapsed All”. You can leave it collapsed and you will see the view as it is shown above, or you can click **Expand All** (highlighted and circled above). For now, let’s assume you leave it Collapse All. You then click on each individual Lesson Topic within them. If you click “**Introduction to 200 RYT Live Classes**” you will see the page below, but please note you will have to SCROLL DOWN to see this (**please scroll down or you won’t see it! Note this is only an example...if you are taking Aqua Yoga, Prenatal, etc., you will see the materials for those classes here.**)



From there, you can click each individual component. For example, if you click **Expiration**, you will see the following page:




I've marked 4 important areas:

#1. Back to Lesson (takes you back to the Lesson Topics)

#2. Course Discussion - show below. This is a discussion forum. Notice the "Show" box highlighted in yellow. You can select what you want to see. You can make comments , add "likes" or make replies to other

students. We just set this up and I am hopeful we will use it for course discussions in the future.

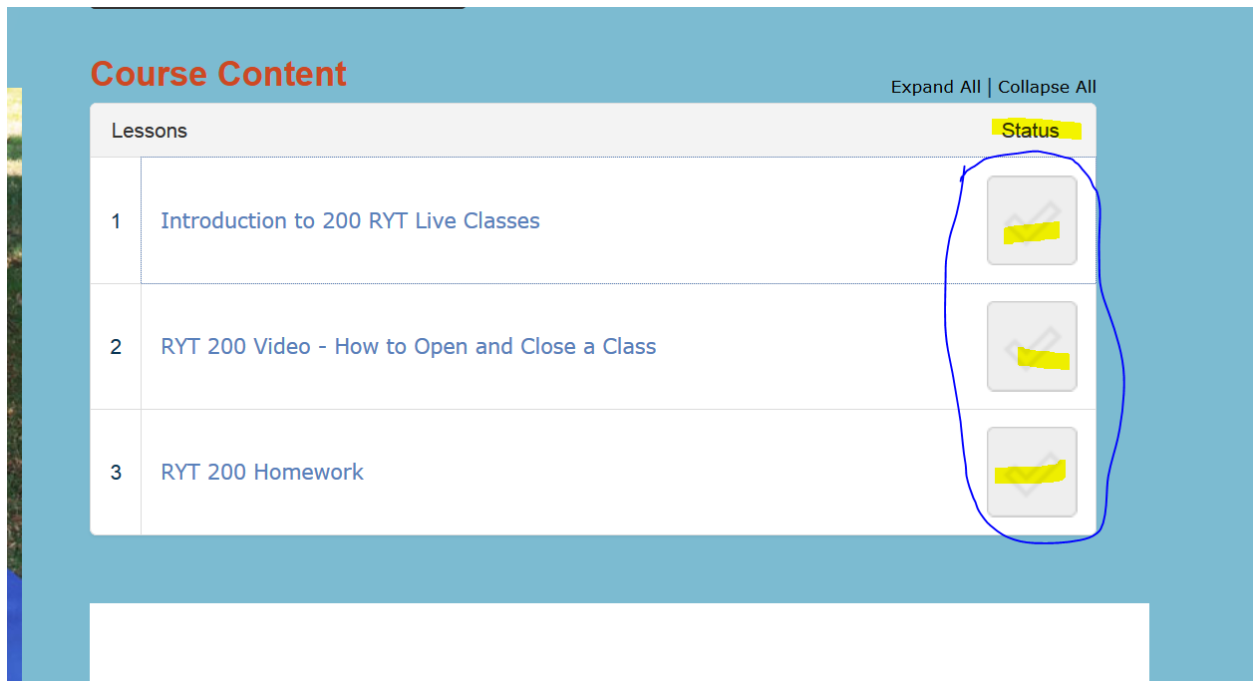

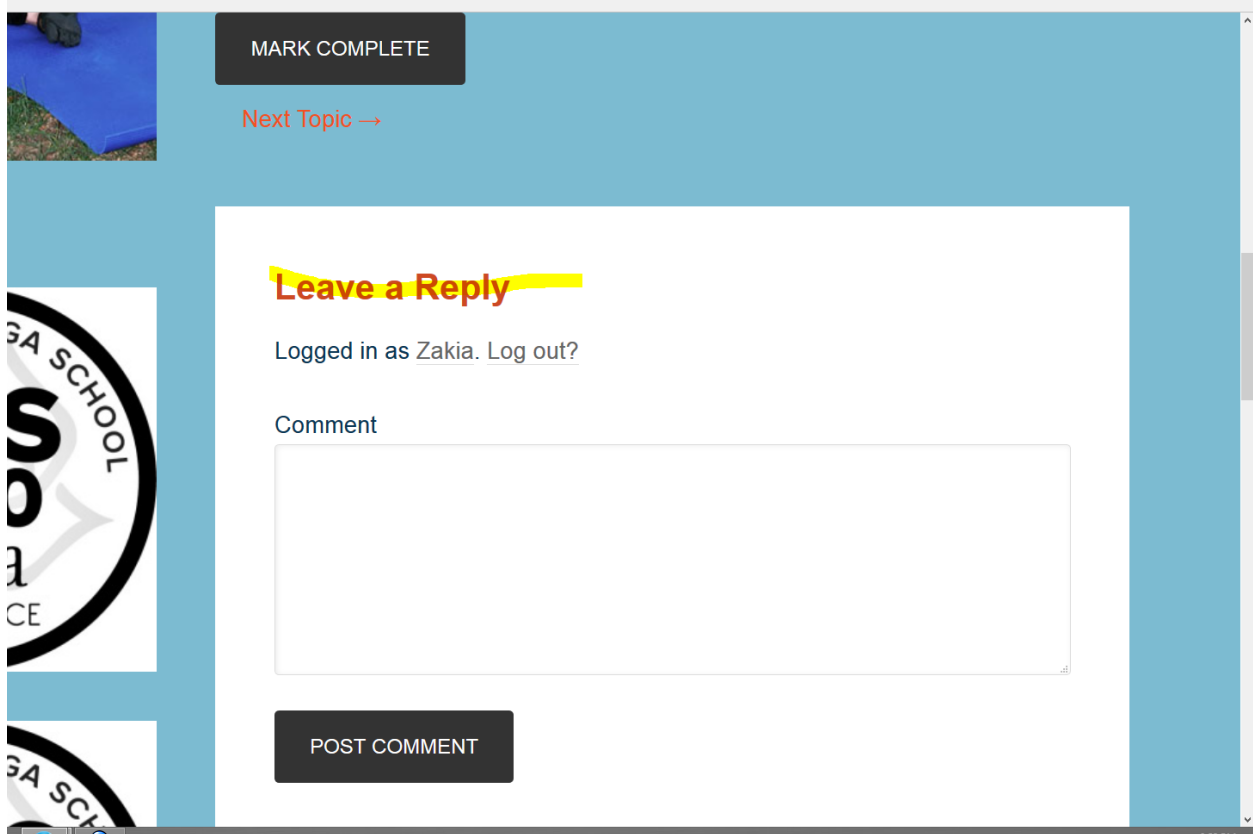
#3. Mark Complete – If you mark a topic complete, it's just a way to help track what you have finished. For example, after you read the information about the course expiration, you could mark it complete to help you know what you've finished reading. This is especially helpful for tracking videos you've watched or homework you've finished. Once you have finished marking every Lesson Topic of a Lesson complete, it will mark it completed with a checkmark. I've shown the screen below and indicated where you'd see this, but this one is not yet marked complete.

(Note: A "Lesson" are the parts such as 1) Intro to 200 RYT Live classes, 2) RYT 200 Video – How to Open and Close a Class and 3) RYT 200 Homework, whereas a "Lesson Topic" are parts such as "Expiration", "Materials", "Required Books and Materials". Don't worry too much about this though. It's just how we categorize the courses, but I want you to know the difference between completing a "Lesson Topic" versus completing a "Lesson".)



#4 Next Topic – Takes you to the next topic in the course

Another feature on each Lesson is the ability to leave a comment (again, Scroll Down to see this). This is convenient because if you are on a page where you are viewing a video and you think of a question or want to make a comment about that particular video, it's good to have a place to leave a question/comment without having to go back to an email or contact form. Also, it allows other students to see the question or comment.



Remember where we showed you about Collapsing or Expanding the topics? Let's look at what happens when you click Expand All (here's a reminder of where we did that):

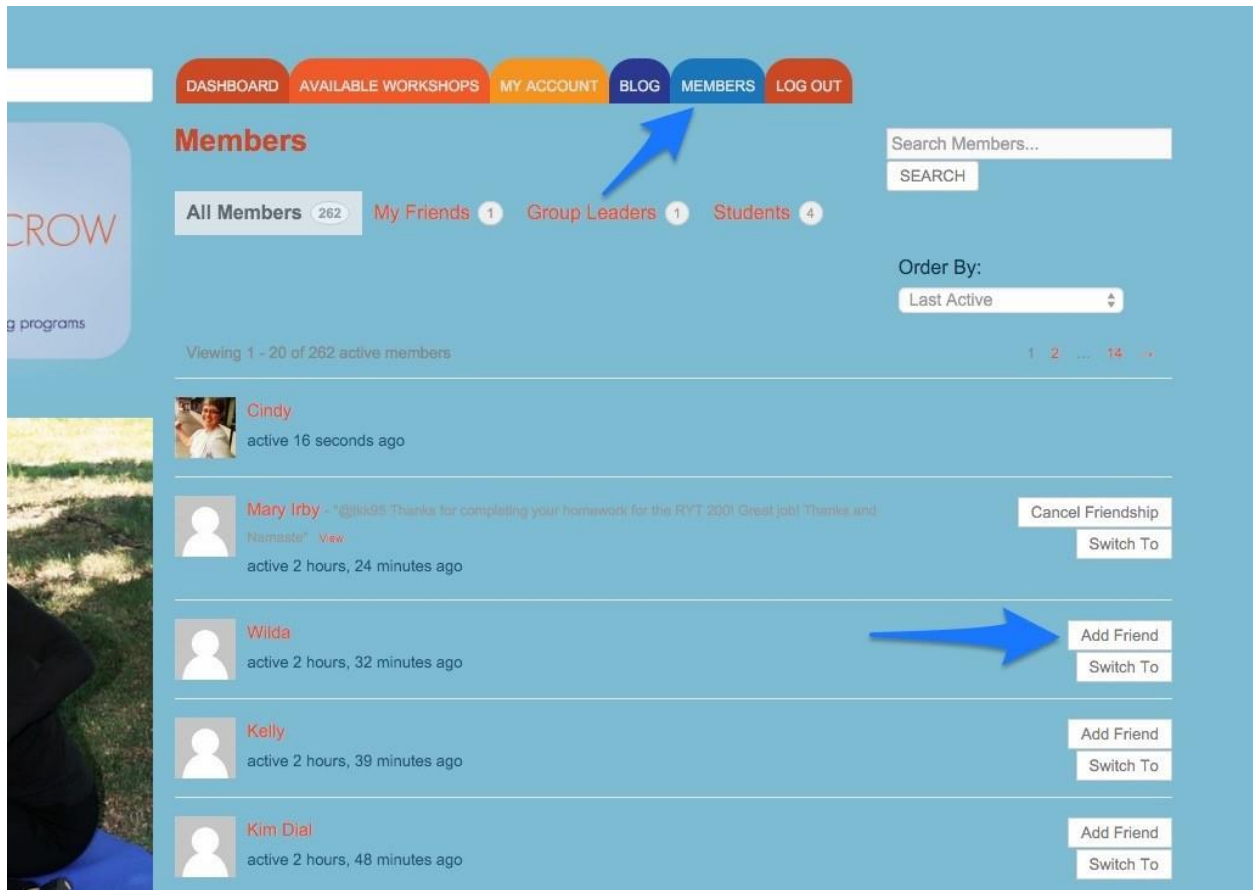
